» Why

Approximately 70% of young people from Christian homes abandon the church by age 18, claiming that the Bible is unreliable or out-of-date.

For those that remain in the faith, their walk is often hampered by doubt, challenges, and temptations which they are often ill-equipped to address. Our humanistic culture is fundamentally at odds with Christian values, and many find it increasingly difficult to proclaim their faith publicly.

Our goal is to train young minds to defend their faith, apply the truth of the Bible to all areas of their life, and to transform the culture they live in by boldly proclaiming the truth of God's Word. By investing in them now, we can look forward to seeing a lasting impact in their lives and in the transformation of those they influence as God works through them.



» Children's resources

Answers in Genesis has long been committed to providing Christian parents/educators with the highest quality apologetics and worldview resources for children, including homeschool curriculum, Sunday school, and Vacation Bible School (VBS) material for church programs as well for ages 3–13.

» Camps

For students ages 14–18, AiG–Canada holds Answers Boot Camps to promote Christian worldview training through the teaching of apologetics (focused but not limited to the topic of origins), personal evangelism strategies, and cultural analysis.

» Mentorship Program

AiG–Canada has developed relationships with many Christian scientists who are staunch biblical creationists and are willing to mentor qualified Christian students pursuing a degree in science. For those young adults interested, AiG–Canada can help introduce a credentialed mentor involved in a similar field of interest as the student to help them navigate the (often difficult) road involved in attaining a PhD or other post-secondary degrees in a secular institution. By their regularly scheduled meetings (either in person if possible or through electronic media), mentors can help their mentees through prayer, answering questions, and providing insight and advice throughout their education.
